LIFE STREAM KIDS VALUES BIBLICAL TEACHING, INVESTED LEADERS, SAFE ENVIRONMENTS, AND FUN EXPERIENCES.

Life Stream Kids is our Children's Ministry (Birth- 5th Grade) that gathers Sunday mornings year-round. It consists of B3 (Birth - 3 years), Kid's Club (3s - 5s), the Hub (Kindergarten - 3rd Grade), and Studio 45 (4th & 5th Grade). We partner with parents to help kids build an authentic relationship with the living God, who loves them and wants to be their forever friend!

This year, we've been more intentional about partnering with parents and families. We have consistently had a monthly email for Kids Club and the Hub/Studio 45. The Parent Resource Center has also become more relevant with information and resources to assist parents in their journeys of raising Christ-like kids.

We are so grateful for our Life Stream Kids leaders, who continue to build Christ-Centered relationships with the kids in these programs! IDENTITY (9th - 12th Grade)



This year's theme has been EVERYDAY. We've asked students to ask the question of what an everyday faith looks like in their lives. In asking that question, we've seen God move in absolutely incredible moments in the lives of students outside of the walls of the Church building. Students have time and again come back to the

understanding that their faith isn't only on Sunday but exists every other day of the week, too.

Our MDWK programming on Wednesday nights has taken the time to ask students what questions they have and what books of the Bible they want to study. In doing so, we've tackled topics from "Why do denominations exist?" to "What does the Bible really say about Heaven and Hell?" Our students have a desire to know the truth of Jesus and on MDWK nights we talk about that truth as we encounter it in our everyday lives and circumstances.

Life Stream Student Programming is every Sunday night during the school year at Life Stream Church from 6:30 - 8:00 PM. Identity's MDWK programming meets every Wednesday night during the school year in The Studio from 8:00 - 9:00 PM.



I knew I was being called to help lead high school students, so I signed up and got started right away. These girls have blessed me beyond measure, and I truly believe we have built such a special bond. It's been great being involved with Identity not only helping the sophomore girls navigate high school and their walks with Christ but also selfishly as I've learned so much. 08 YOUNG ADULTS



LIFE STREAM YOUNG ADULTS is a group for people from 18-30 years old looking to connect with other people in a similar stage of life. This group has been meeting since November of 2023 for a weekly Bible study diving into Romans, Ecclesiastes, and James so far. Their focus has been on growing in their relationships with Jesus and knowledge of His living Word. Their future summer plans include continuing to meet for Bible studies, bonfires, volleyball, worship, & serving the community. God is moving in this group of young adults as they strive to know Him better through community with each other!









08 GROUPS

From September of 2023 until now, Life Stream has seen growth in the numbers of small groups offered as well as the number of people attending. Since September, we launched two new Women's Groups (Thursday Evening Women's Bible Study and Faith and Feet), a new Men's Bible study (Tuesday Night Men's Bible Study), and older adult Bible study (Fellowship Group), and an additional young couples' group (Couples with Kids). In addition, we advertised a group that had been meeting and was looking for new members (Midstream on the Lakeshore). Planning Center was updated to reflect group options for interested people as well as the website and a new interview process was implemented for new group leaders.

We have 27 people dedicated to the leadership of Small Groups and approximately 185 people connected to a Small Group at Life Stream.

Even in the midst of pastoral transition and small group leadership transition, God is still moving and people want connection and a community to grow deeper in their faith.
