As I reflect on the last year and the season of ministry we have been in as a church, I'm reminded of those words by Jesus in the book of Matthew. 2000 years ago, Christ set the church in motion and it has been growing and changing the world ever since. His words are still as powerful and relevant for us today.

"I will build..."

I love the emphatic voice Jesus uses. There is no question He is going to build His church here on earth, but we get to partner with Jesus in this work. Everyday we are given the chance to bring hope to those who have none. To show the world what freedom in Jesus really looks like, and to be light in a world filled with far too much darkness. He is building His church, but we must never forget he does it with our hands and feet.

Life Stream belongs to Jesus and that is great news. It's His church, always has been and always will be. And His love for this church took him to the cross. He gave himself away and set the example. Over this past year we have given ourselves away and the results are exciting...

This past year:

- We baptized 28 people
- We dedicated 22 children
- We saw 47 people make first time commitments to Jesus
- Nearly 1500 people attended our Easter Sunday services, with another 400 watching online
- On average, 100 plus kids participate in one of our kids ministry environments every Sunday
- We have approximately 130 people in small groups doing life together and growing in faith
- Our food pantry serves over 40 families each month
- We send out 260 Manna Meals per week to benefit kids at Allendale Public Schools
- And so much more!

"...and nothing will stop it..."

And this is a promise. A promise made by the God of the universe, that nothing can stop the expansion of His church on earth. There is no crisis, no economic downturn, global pandemic, or unexpected transition that will stop Jesus from moving his message into the world. Why? Because it's His church and He will build it.

So as we turn the corner on a new fiscal year, we look forward with hope and anticipation at what JESUS will do. His promise still stands true and Life Stream is still His church. We only need to stay desperate for the Holy Spirit and trust that Jesus is moving in our midst to do greater things than we can expect or imagine.

I believe what Jesus has always known....


GOD IS GOOD!

LIFE STREAM KIDS (BIRTH-5TH)

"The mission of Life Stream Kids is to help children and families learn what it means to LIVE and SHARE the story of GOD."

Life Stream Kids is our Children's Ministry (Birth-5th Grade) that gathers Sunday mornings year-round. It consists of B3 (Birth - 3 years), Kid's Club (3s - 5s), the Hub (K - 3rd Grade) and Studio 45 (4th & 5th Grade). We partner with parents to help kids build an authentic relationship with the living God, who loves them and wants to be their forever friend!

We also have a Wednesday night program called Journey that gathers during the school year for our Kindergarten through 5th Grade students. There, kids are encouraged to memorize scripture, have fun, and learn how to live and share the story of God.

We have seen a huge desire to learn more about God and be in the Bible. We have had kids attend in-person, as well as engaging in our online weekly curriculum. Kids have been helping each other find passages of scripture and asking for prayer for their friends and family members, really coming together as the Body of Christ to lift one another up.

Our Life Stream Kids leaders have been so intentional about building Christ-Centered relationships with the kids in these programs and we are so excited to see what happens in the next year!

I absolutely LOVE working with the kiddos! They have taught me patience and also how amazing our God is that he has created these kiddos so unique. I was so amazed how much grace the kids gave me as I was figuring out my role as a volunteer. God truly blessed me with this amazing opportunity.

Identity

is our High School Ministry which meets on Sunday nights.

The theme of "Revival" has been at the heartbeat of our ministry this year and we have seen God do some amazing things through this. Students have said "Yes" to following God for the first time, built Christ-centered relationships with our amazing team of invested leaders, and have even heard God calling them into ministry!

In our MDWK Wednesday night program we dove deep into the Bible and addressed topics about Christ and Cultural Issues, "How to Church", and a walkthrough of Genesis. Sunday nights have had powerful moments of worship, prayer, and surrender. Christ is moving in this generation and revival is coming!



"Identity has been a really good place for me to go to deepen my relationship with God and ask questions about my faith. YOUNG ADULTS

Life Stream Young Adults is a brand new ministry that we started to meet the need for community in those aged 18-30 in our midst. Additionally, our hearts were burdened for those at GVSU right down the road who do not yet know Jesus! On November 13, 2022 we gathered for the first time after church for a free lunch and were thrilled to have about 40 people in attendance. Since then, we have continued to meet each month and see between 25-45 young adults at every gathering.

Our heart was to create a place where young adults could meet friends, and meet Jesus. We have done this by launching 5 small groups that meet twice / month. There are groups for male, female, co-ed, and engaged / married young adults. This is where community, accountability, and spiritual growth happens on a deep level! Then, twice per month our small groups all gather together into one room for a worship night on the first Tuesday of each month, and for a free lunch after church later in the month.



We have seen God's hand all over this ministry already, and have heard awesome testimonies about young adults who have met new friends and met Jesus as their Savior (a few of them for the first time)! Our prayer is that God would continue to grow and to bless this group, and that we would see revival break out in the younger generations.

I attended youth group at Life Stream in high school. Upon graduating college, I came back to West Michigan where finding a church and regularly connecting in the local body of Christ was top a priority for me as I navigated life post-graduation. Amidst the search, a friend from high school texted me about Life Stream starting a Young Adult ministry. I attended the Young Adult Lunch where Pastor Chandler introduced his vision for the ministry, shared his experience of young adulthood, and related to my personal struggle to find community after graduating college.

He expressed his desire for this ministry to be a place where all who come can feel seen, welcomed, and known while personally encountering Christ. I knew at that moment that this was the spot the Lord had for me and left that lunch gratefully praising God for answering my prayer.

Fast forward to the end of first semester, I look back in awe to see how the Lord has provided. In a matter of months, the brothers and sisters attending my small group have become my genuine friends and I look forward to each time we gather. The ministry of Life Stream Young Adults is tangible evidence of answered prayers for my heart personally, and it is so awesome to see my brothers and sisters in Christ genuinely loving the Lord, wanting to seek Him together.

Our Good Friday service brought 242 people into our building and outside into our "tree walk" area to view a variety of artwork painted by artists from the congregation as well as acted out stories from Christ's last week of life. One Saturday night service and two Sunday morning services brought nearly 1500 people into the Worship Center to hear about the Resurrection of our Savior!
